- Uttara Bhadrapada completion and introspection




Cancer (Moon)






- American actress and filmmaker


- First son of Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip

<u>Famous Charts – Indira Gandhi</u>


- Prime Minister of India from Ja.19, 1966 to March 24, 1977 and again from 1980 to 1984




<u>Famous Charts – Saddam Hussein</u>

- Rahu- confusion of how to deal with emotions





- His readings dealt with holistic health, philosophy and reincarnation, dreams interpretation, etc.









- Liberator of America.
- Venezuelan military and political leader who led the independence of Colombia,
 Venezuela, Ecuador, Panama, and Peru from the Spanish empire.
- He created the "Gran Colombia" between
 1819 1830 and he was the president.
- He resigned to the presidency intending to leave the country for exile, but he died of tuberculosis.
