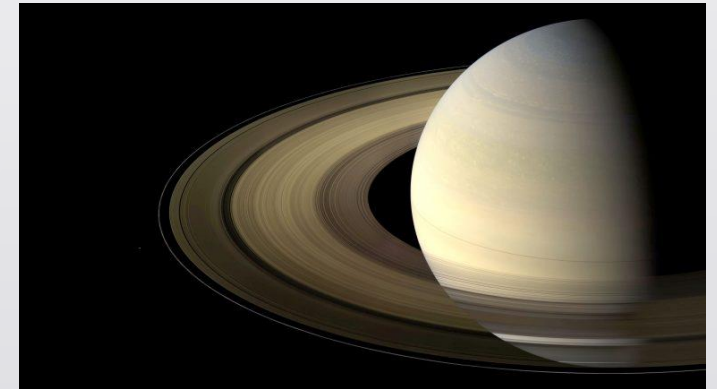

- Emotional sensitive, and shy.

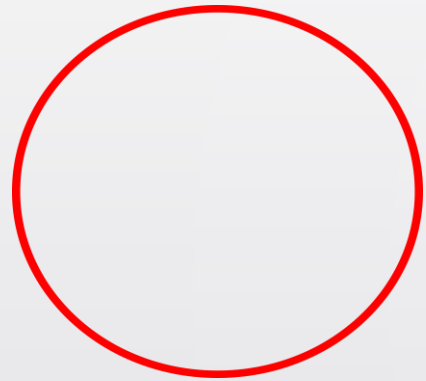

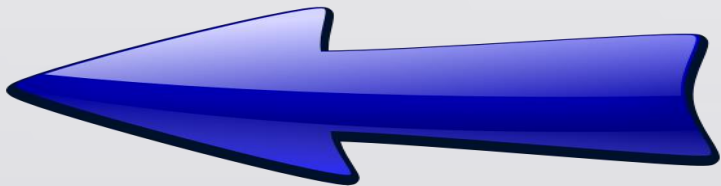

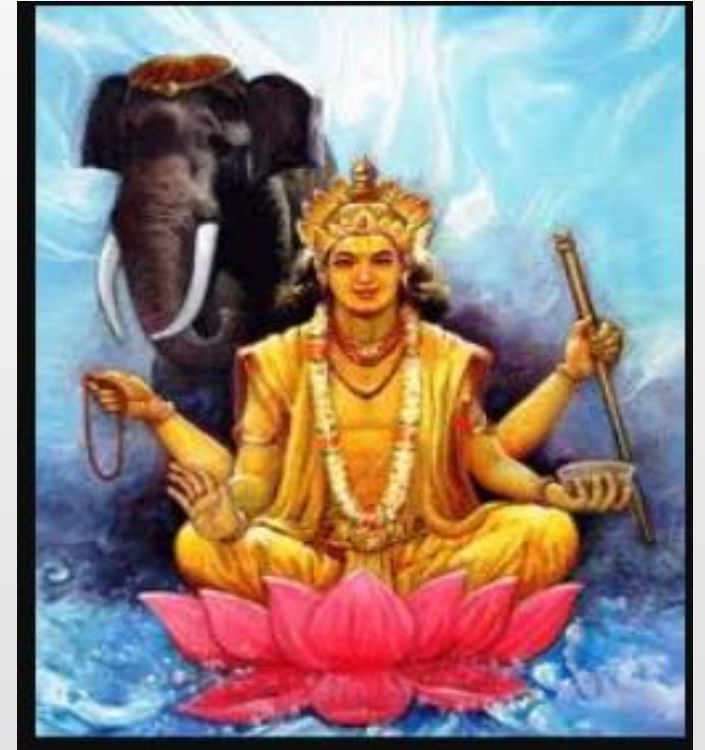

Devata: Brihaspati

- The Priest and chief advisor of the Gods. He advised the gods on their religious duties. He is the teacher of the Gods
- He is the same as the planet of Jupiter
- The attributes of Jupiter applies to this nakshatra (5 degrees of exaltation) and that includes a strong sense of ethics
- Deep words that express a spiritual energy
- Brihaspati, a male deity.

- Mercury – rationality versus intuitive Cancer
- Mars – debilitated /Raja Yogakaraka
- Rahu – struggles / jealousy /addictions
- Ketu – material struggle / guiltiness / full freedom in 4th pada

- Over a decade, she went on more than 40 field missions, meeting with refugees and internally displaced persons in over 30 countries



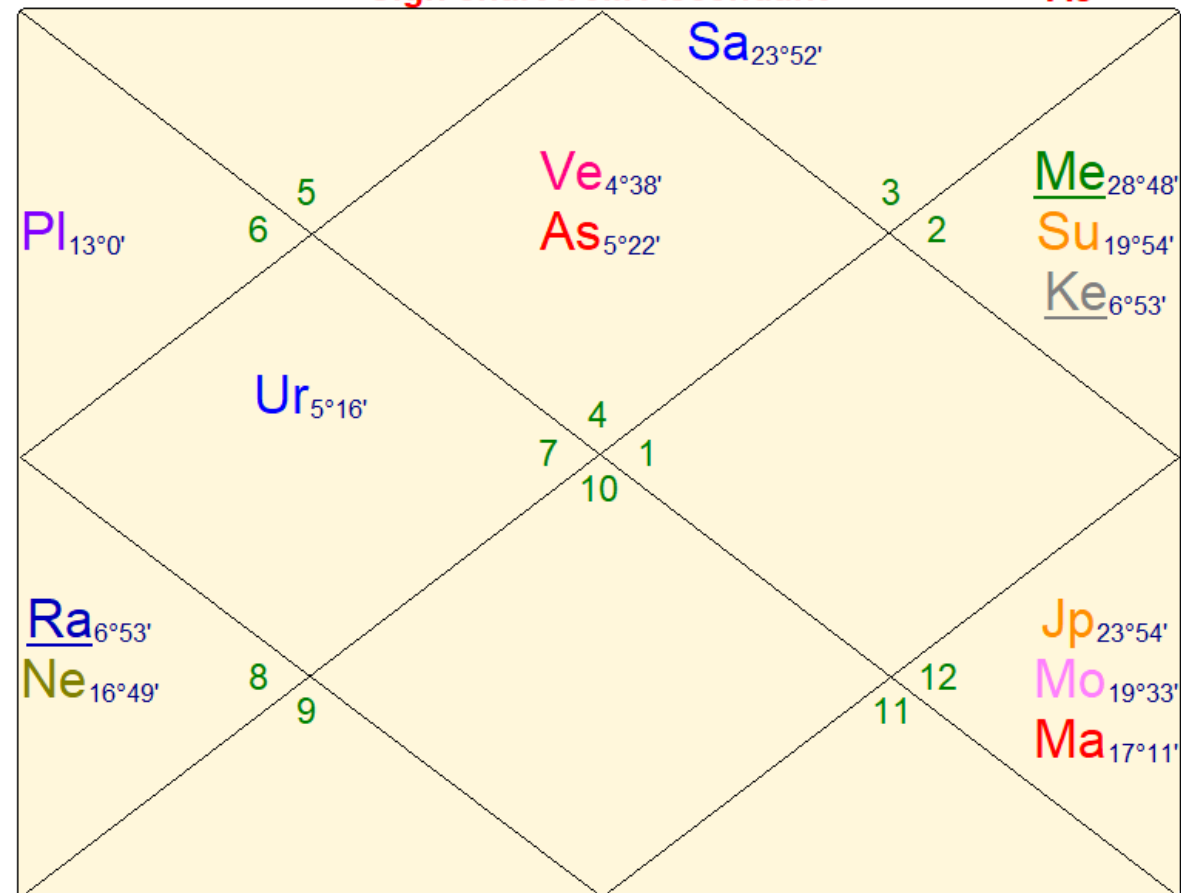

- He loves the country life.



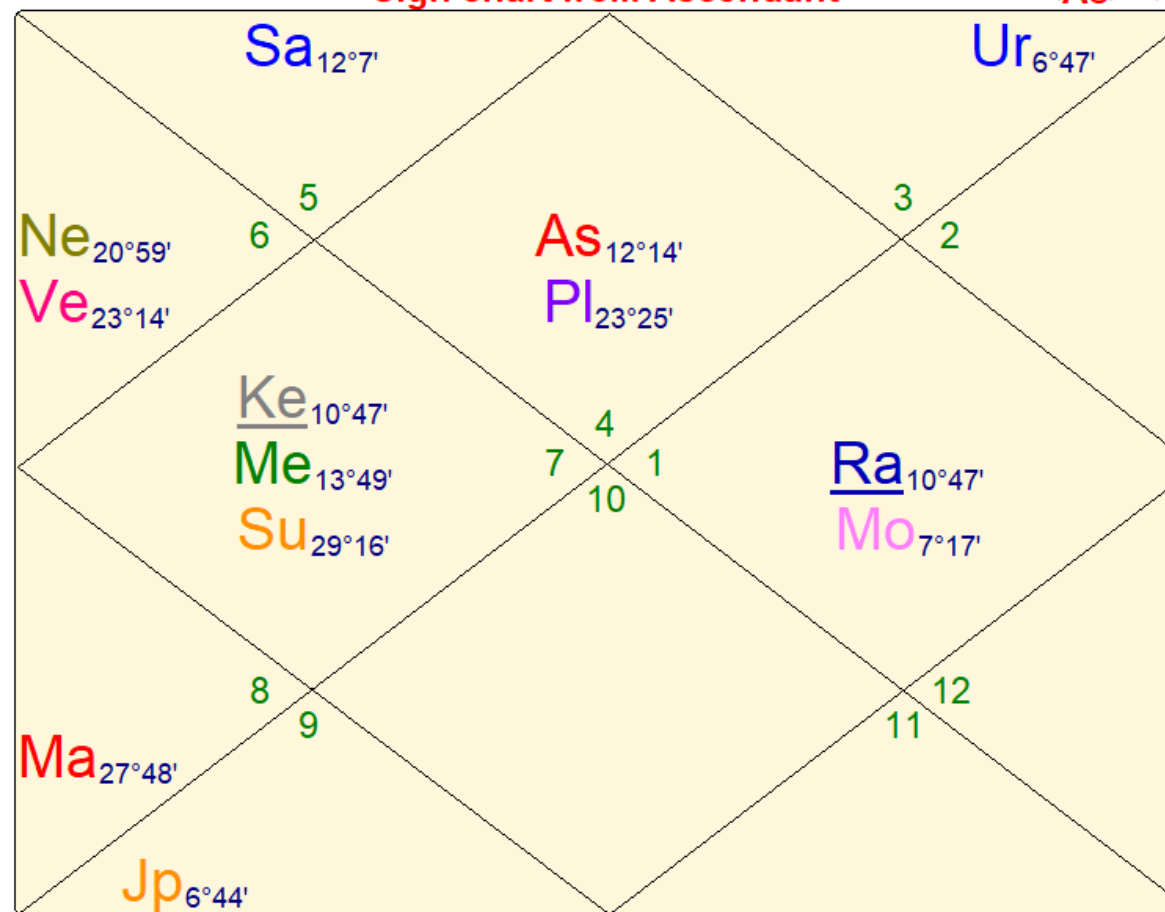

- Prime Minister until voted out
- She was assassinated in Delhi in 1984

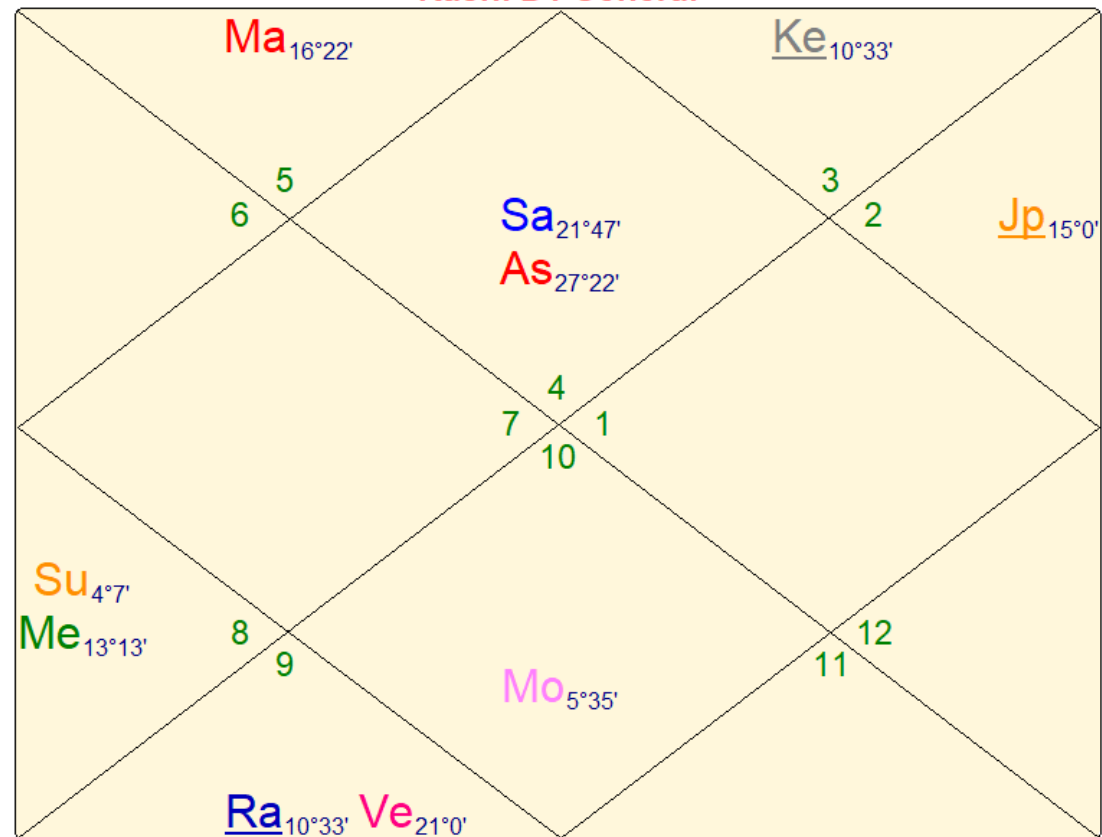

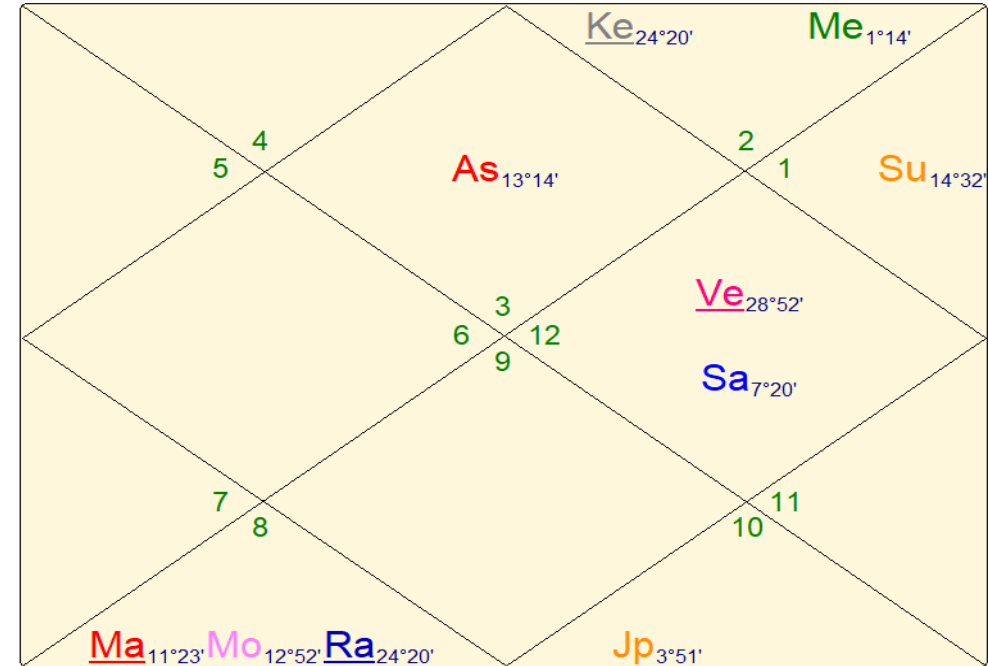

Devata: Ahir Budhnya

- The Dragon of the Depths
- Responsible for the fertility of the earth
- Mystery
- Serpents residing at the bottom of lakes, rivers, and oceans representing the deep sea of eternity
- The serpent represents wisdom
- Male Devata, Jupiter is a male planet, male nakshatra





Ahir Budhnya: “the latter (one who possesses) lucky feet”

Positive qualities:

- Flexibility according to the end, but fixed nakshatra
- Determination
- Wisdom from experience
- Big picture in mind
- Empathy and benevolence, calmness
- Rational
- Inheritances and financial gifts (fortunate)
- A passive warrior

Negative qualities:

- Hard to know the real motives of this nakshatra(water)
- Mental and physical laziness
- Tendency toward weight easily and normally short height
- Even when creates destruction, it is less cruel than Purvabhadrapada
- Reclusive tendencies, which sometimes influence an early retirement

- They might seem calm in order to hide their turbulent mind

- Jupiter – help to overcome inertia / wisdom (aspects)
- Mars – Dynamic planet / passion
- Venus – need relationships / stuck in material desires (padas)
- Sun – dynamic planet / spirituality or ego
- Moon – happy disposition / emotional storm
- Ketu – maturity of the soul but stuck here
- Saturn – constrictions over material attainments / responsibilities
- Mercury – emotional issues vs. intellectuality
- Rahu- confusion of how to deal with emotions

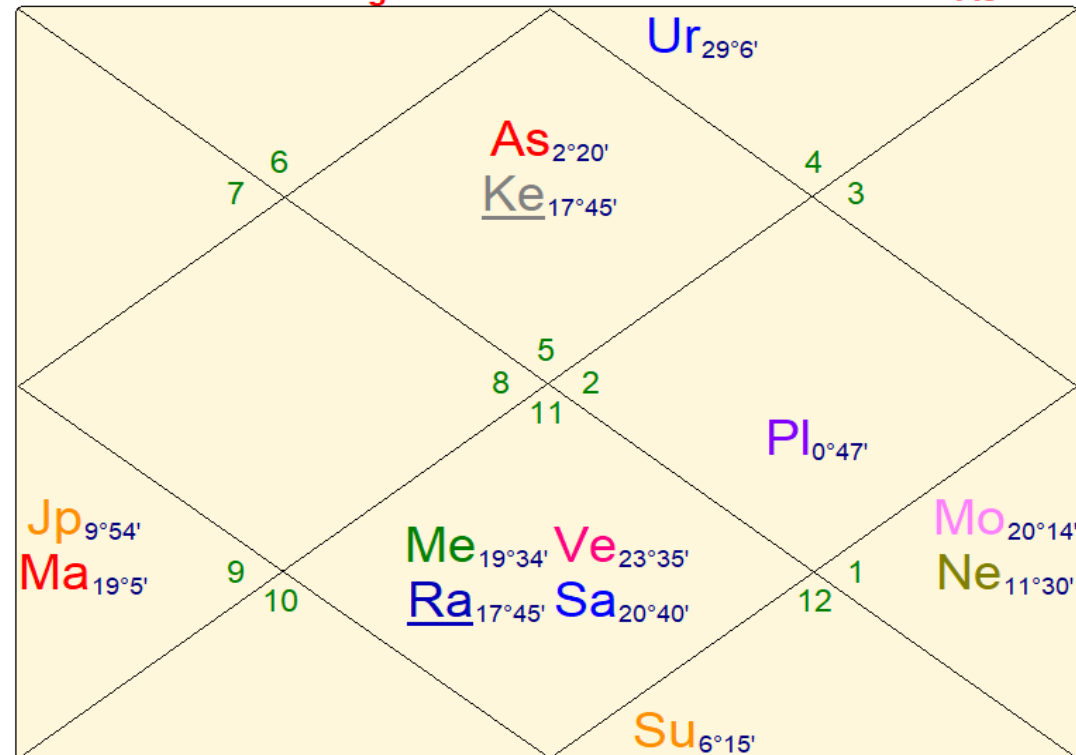

Famous Charts – Simon Bolivar

- July 24, 1783 – December 17, 1830.
- Liberator of America.
- Venezuelan military and political leader who led the independence of Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador, Panama, and Peru from the Spanish empire.
- He created the “Gran Colombia” between 1819 – 1830 and he was the president.
- He resigned to the presidency intending to leave the country for exile, but he died of tuberculosis.

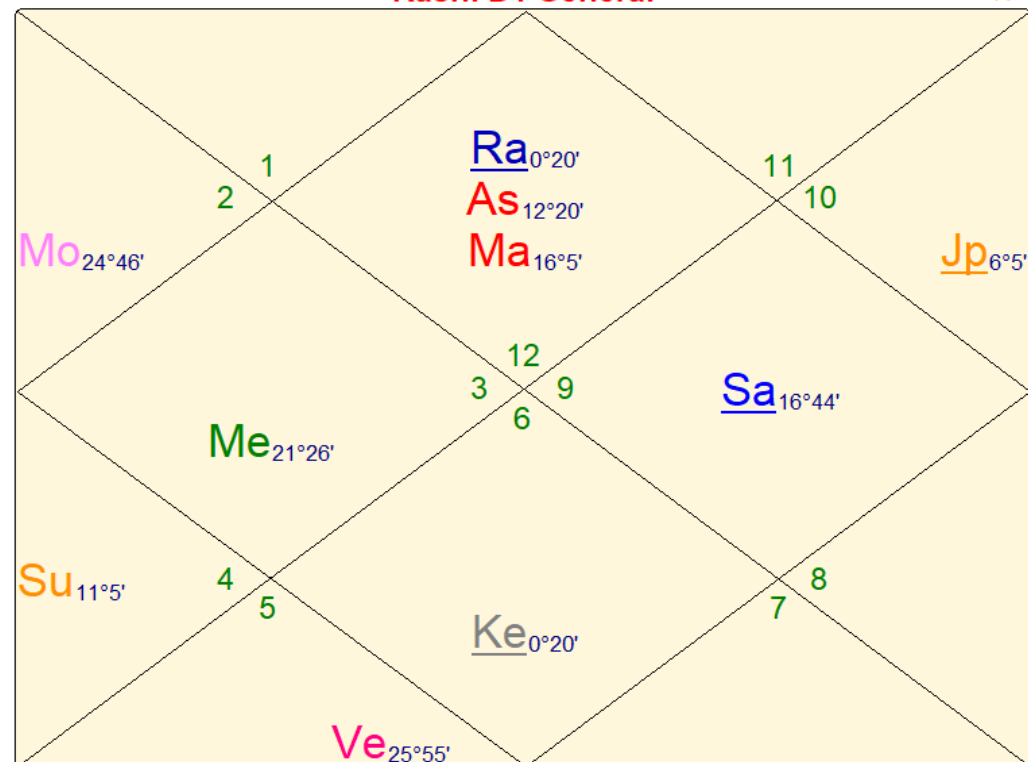
